Got Medicare? Get Help with Costs



If you are single and your income is less than \$ 1,353* a month, you might qualify for extra financial help in paying for your Medicare drug plan's out of pocket costs.

* (\$1,821 for married couples)

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What Type of Help is Available?

Extra financial help with Medicare drug plan expenses ("Extra Help") is available through two separate programs: a Medicare Savings Program (QMB, SLMB, or QI) or the Low Income Subsidy.

Under both programs, you save a lot of money on the cost of your prescriptions. Monthly drug plan payments are greatly reduced and, if you currently pay a deductible, it may be significantly less—possibly nothing at all.

If you qualify for a Medicare Savings Program, you will have the extra benefit of no longer having to pay the \$96.40 monthly Medicare part B premium. Depending on income, you may also not have to make co-payments for visits to the doctor and stays in the hospital.

The amount of Extra Help you receive depends upon your income and the value of your assets.

Who Qualifies for Extra Help?

You qualify for a **Medicare Savings Program** and Extra Help if your income is below **\$1,219** a month (**\$1,640** for a married couple) and your assets are worth less than \$8,100 (\$12,910 if married). **This number changes** every April.

You qualify for Extra Help through the **Low Income Subsidy** only if your income is below **\$1,353** a month (**\$1,821** for a married couple) and your assets are worth less than \$12,500 (\$25,010 if married).

Not all types of income and assets are counted in deciding whether you qualify. Use this chart as a guide:

Not All Income and Assets Count in Determining Eligibility

Count

- Your and your spouse's income
- Cash and items readily converted to cash
- Stocks and bonds
- Checking and saving accounts
- Retirement accounts
- Whole life insurance with face value above \$1,500
- Property (other than the home you live in)

Don't Count

- Income of other dependents in your household
- Your primary residence or home
- Your car
- A burial space
- Personal items (e.g., jewelry, household goods)
- Funeral and burial expenses up to \$1,500
- In kind gifts or contributions from others (e.g. food, rent/mortgage, utility bills)

How Do I Get the Extra Financial Help?

If you think you might qualify for Extra Help through a **Medicare Savings Program**, you may apply by mail or in person at your local Income Support Division Office. You may also get help by phone by leaving a message at (505) 222-4508.
